VISAKHAPATNAM: Many prominent statisticians were present as the fiveday international conference on "statistics, probability, operations research, computer science and its allied areas" commenced at Andhra University on Monday.

The conference coincided with the eighth International Indian Statistical Association's joint statistical meeting and the 29th annual convention of Indian Society for Probability and Statistics (ISPS) and is being organised by AU Department of Statistics.

Ninety-year-old Prof. C.R. Rao of Penn State University (US), considered a doyen of statistics, in his keynote address said that statistics and stochastic modelling were the hub of present research for which data mining, data interpretation and data intelligence were essential.

engineering and also epidemiology dynamics.
